Virtual Pet Parade — The La Grange Pet Parade Planning Committee, consisting of local community volunteers, has decided to change the 2020 parade to a virtual online event for health and safety purposes. Rave Alert/Smart911 Emergency Notification System — The Village has transitioned from its current emergency notification system, CodeRed, to the RaveAlert / Smart 911 Emergency Notification System. Residents can sign up for emergency notifications through Rave Alert / Smart 911 at this time. Notifications through CodeRed ended on May 1, 2020. COVID-19 — On April 30, Governor Pritzker extended the Stay at Home Order through the end of May to limit the spread of COVID-19. The Order requires face coverings to be worn in indoor places such as grocery stores and pharmacies. Face coverings are also required in other public places anytime that six feet of distance from others cannot be maintained. The requirement applies to all individuals over the age of two who are medically able to tolerate a face covering or mask.

The extension of the Order also allows non-essential businesses, in addition to restaurants, to offer curbside pick-up and delivery options beginning May 1. Please continue to support all of our businesses through curbside pick-up and delivery options as often as possible.

On May 5, Governor Pritzker unveiled a phased plan to reopen Illinois by region called Restore Illinois. The five-phase plan is guided by public health metrics designed to provide a framework for reopening businesses, education and recreational activities in each phase. May 29 is the earliest that any region could move from the current Phase 2 to Phase 3.

The Village website provides resources to residents and businesses regarding COVID-19 and the Village's response. Information regarding how you can support businesses and assist during the crisis is also provided.

While the Village Hall is closed to the public, essential Village services continue as normal. Residents are asked to please use the online and phone options available to transact Village business.

The Village continues to recognize the first responders, medical workers, grocery store and restaurant workers, and so many others working to provide care and comfort during this difficult time.
