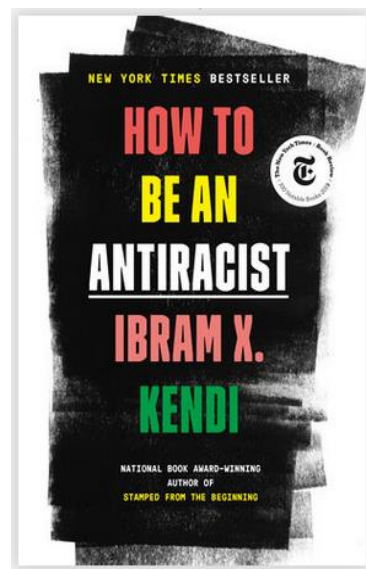
## FRIDAY NIGHT – 2020 Summer Read
